### "Dollar Diplomacy"

- Dollar Diplomacy - the use of economic ties is the best way to expand American influence
- Taft encouraged U.S. bankers & businesses to invest large amounts of money in Asia & Latin America

## Woodrow Wilson

### "Moral Diplomacy"

- Wilson believed that the aim of U.S. foreign policy should be to support democracy

## Theodore Roosevelt

### "Big Stick"

- wanted to prevent Europe from becoming too powerful in Latin America
- Roosevelt Corollary to the Monroe Doctrine
  - Corollary - extension (or add-on) of a doctrine or document
  - Said that when neighbors of the U.S. get into disputes with foreign nations, the U.S. had the right to use international police power to restore order
